November 15, 1995 Permit issued, Zoning report shows the use must be private use, storage and excercise equipment. Letter from Sam Hoffses requires that the structure be used for "excercise & storage only"

10/3/97 Applied for a permit to add 12' x 21' to the principle dwelling. Zoning review revealed an issue with a sign saying "Horseshoes" on the fence, posed the question of a change of use without permit. Owner notified of this.

10/14/97 Letter from owner to Zoning Admin advising that the sign had been removed and the use of the property has never changed, A rec. room for his family and that "it is not being used for any business activity"
