RE: Request for Certificate of Appropriateness for Restoration and Improvements to 98 Carroll Street Residence

Dear Deborah,

On behalf of our client Mr. Derek Leck, owner of the two story house and garage at 98 Carroll Street, we submit for your review and the boards approval documents describing Mr. Leck's goal to both restore the house to it's original 1915 appearance and make a few select improvements to his property. Architectural features are as follows,

- Restore the balustered railing on Sunroom and Library Bay to match the balustered railing on the upper dormer at the main north elevation. Install a new balustered railing above the east entry porch roof to match the other two low roofs, and conceal a condenser unit for a new central air-conditioning system.
- 2. Replace all the second level slatted wood shutters with wood panel shutters matching the existing first level window shutters and center window shutters on the second level above the main entrance.
- 3. Replace the current garage door with a wood door with glass lites that match the original garage door shown in a 1924 photo.
- 4. Install gated black metal side yard fence either similar the neighbor's at 199 Western Promenade or of a black metal fence appropriate to the neighborhood. Install shrubs behind the fence.
- Install new gas lights on the main entrance patio piers or on both sides of the granite steps, and above the garage door to create safer, illuminated access.
- 6. Remove existing exterior storm windows, repair and repaint, and install interior storm windows

The enclosed application photographs, drawings, material specifications and equipment suppliers are provided to illustrate how Mr. Leck is making a concerted effort to restore his house to it's original grandeur while requesting a few improvements that are in character with the era of the house while providing greater security and safer entry.
