

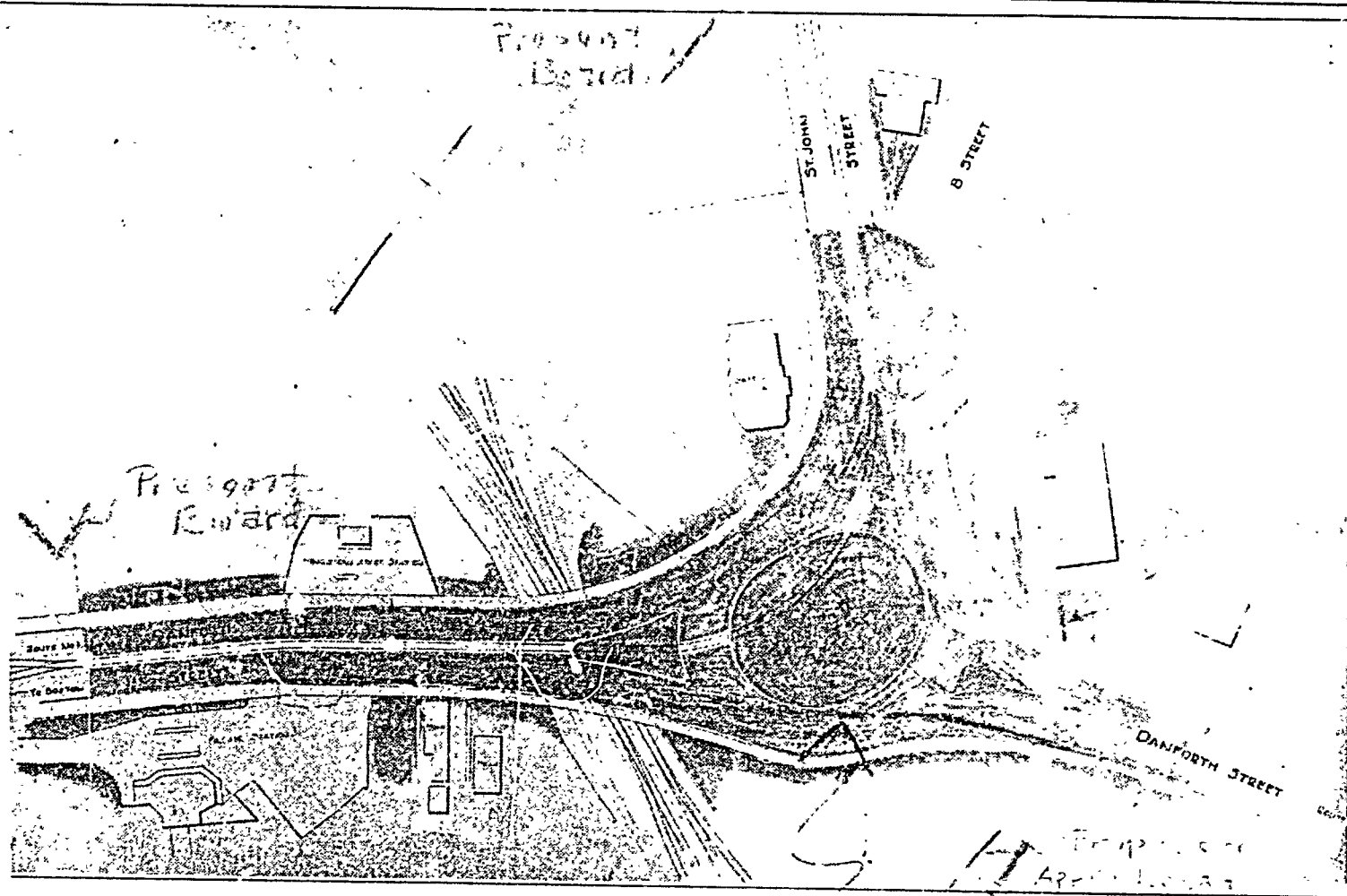

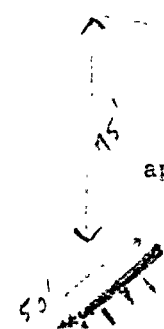

The Municipal Officers were unwilling to approve the relocation, and the applying Company notified verbally that they wish to withdraw the application to relocate. 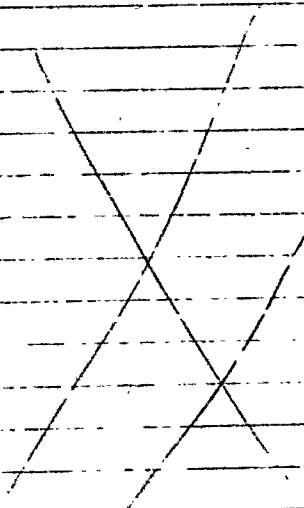

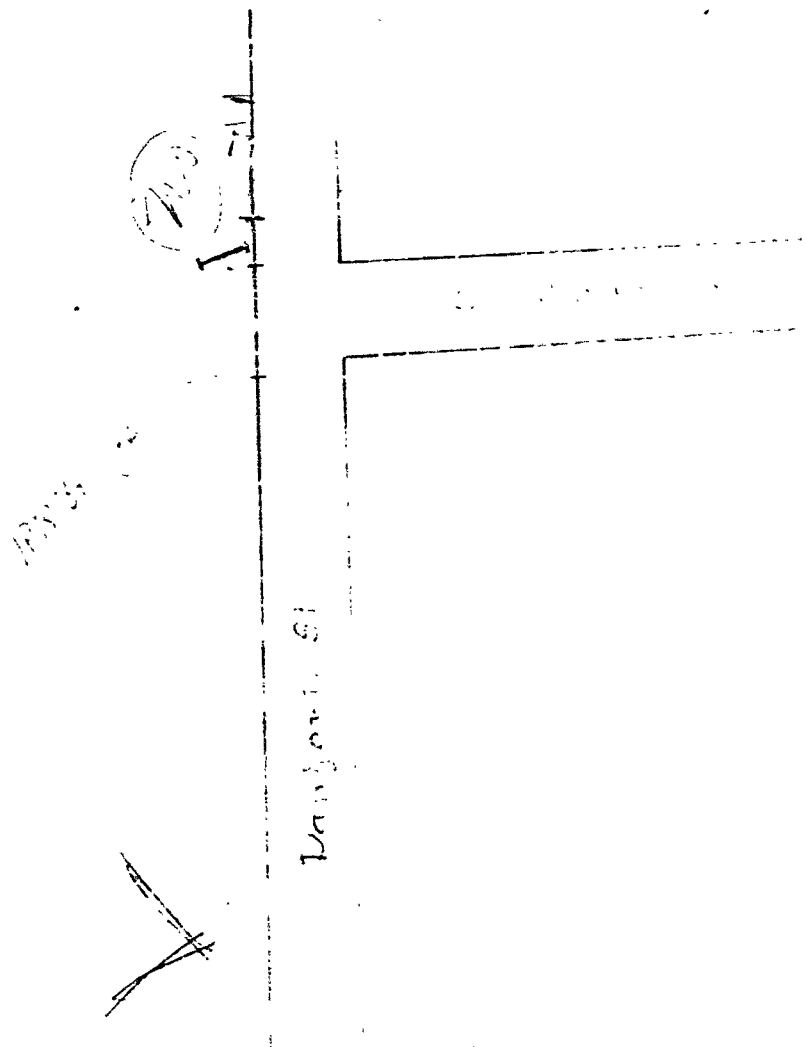
