Dear Mr. Weyker:

In examining your inquiry of Mr. Sears of this office relating to the above subject, I merely wish to add the information that storage of explosives is not an allowable use in the Industrial Zone where this property is.

Probably this is a needless precaution in writing thus to you, but it is being brought to our attention quite forcibly by all the safety people now that certain fertilizers are highly explosive or highly inflammable, and if any of the fertilizer which you propose to store in such a building were of that type, there would be a question as to whether or not that storage would be allowable under the Zoning Ordinance.
