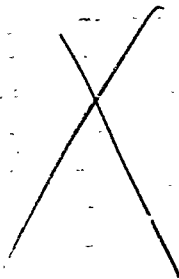

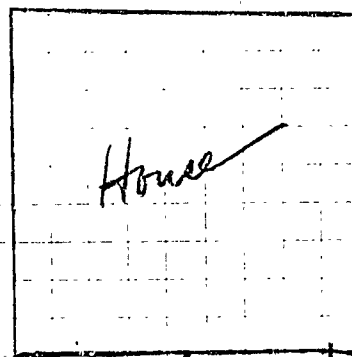


(A) APARTMENT HOUSE ZONE
