- 1. Design Cert Application there is a discrepancy on the type of construction here (3B) and on the cover page of the plans (5B), please clarify, sorry yes we did our code review as a 5B, 95% of the building is 3B but we have a section of 5B so we analyzed under 5B
- 2. Provide a statement of special inspections for the new steel framed addition, we will provide
- 3. Provide an electronic copy of the project specifications documents We will provide
- 4. Plan A0.02 verify the X'd out (shaft or opening) near unit 107A and above the kitchen exhaust shaft it is wall type W5shown on A1.01 and A1.02, Also I picked up that it was incorrectly labeled on A1.03 so we have adjusted to W5 see revised A1.03.
- 5. Provide tempered window locations per Sec. 2406, See revised Window Schedule drawing A5.10
- 6. Plan A3.10 wall section justify the thermal break at the exterior foundation wall from the rigid insulation at grade to the wood framed wall I don't understand what the problem is with this detail
- 7. Plan A3.11 Justify exterior pipe rail compliance deviation of code requirements for the opening limitations & height Section 3409 Historic Buildings. This project is a designated historic landmark being rebuilt under the requirements of the National Park Service. Also all railings approved by Portland HP board we hope to receive

your blessing that these railings do not constitute a distinct life safety.

- 8. Plan A.100 It appears the entry doors at Units 111A & 102A impede on 1/2 the egress width for Units 111B & 102B per Sec. 1005.2 We will change all these and have doors swing in See revised plan A1.00.
- 9. Plan A8.00 The Unit lockout doors U-11 should maintain the sleeping unit fire rated separation, please Confirm yes we will show as one hour see revised Door Schedule A8.00
- 10. Plan A1.00 Basement units 101, 102, 111, 112 entry doors and partition walls are within a 1 hour rated exit enclosure, not a corridor. Justify the assigned wall types and door rating agree we will show as one hour see revised plan drawing A1.00
- 11. Plan A3.20 Clarify wall types for partitions at stair #5, door #63 is 1 hour rated but he partitions aren't noted on detail8 and 9 A3.20 as one hour
- 12. Plan A3.20 Provide stair section C for stair #2 shown above plan on drawing but see revised drawing A3.20
- 13. Plan A7.02 Provide stair dimensional details for the individual sleeping units, note Sec. 1009.4.2.5 does include R-1 in the exception see revised drawing A7.02
- 14. Provide exterior stair section and dimensional details see revised stair section drawing A3.11
- 15. Are plumbing and mechanical plans completed, at least schematics? We do not have these at this time.
