Hi Jeanie,

Thank you. Oops!! Of course I know I am supposed to support documents in PDF! I forgot and I'm sorry. I have attached a .pdf version to this email.

About the other items -- the only work being done is to install the circular stairway. Every other element of the second floor is as it was when we purchased the house in May, 2013.

1. I have attached the .pdf files
2. There is no new bathroom. The bathroom is as it was when we bought the house.
3. No changes are being made to the exterior stairs. They are as they were when we bought the house.
4. Nothing is being altered in any way except for the installation of the circular stairway. There isn't a "kitchen" as a separate room on the second floor. There is a sink, which I did not draw since you wanted to know how the space would be occupied, and the only use of the space will be as a bedroom. But the sink will remain where it was when we bought the house, and there are no plans to remove it. Nothing has been removed and there are no plans to remove the sink. There are no other installed appliances. NO changes are being made to anything on the second floor except for the installation of the circular stairway.

1. The files for the plans must be submitted in PDF format.
2. It appears there is a new bathroom on the 2nd floor, is this part of the work for this application? This is not on the project description. The original permit was for a first floor remodel.

3. The "existing" exterior stairs to the 2nd floor is not shown on any previous plans or the site plan. Please include this on the site plan and when it was built.
4. Floor framing plans and location of the for the new opening for the spiral stair.
5. Provide an existing 2nd floor plan that indicates removal of the kitchen.

Hi Ann,

I have reviewed the details submitted. The spiral stair information is adequate, however there are some additional details required prior to permit issuance.

Rory, please provide these detailed plans:

1. Floor framing details for the new opening for the spiral stair
2. A second floor plan showing how the space will be occupied, ie. bedrooms, living area, etc. If bedrooms, provide egress window specifications.
3. A section of the house showing the second floor ceiling height.
4. An electrical plan for the 2nd floor including smoke/co detectors and wiring

This review and approval cannot continue without these details. I will be on vacation starting Mon. Aug 4, Tammy Munson or Laurie Leader can proceed with the review when the details are submitted.
