Here is the text. That space on the form just kept getting smaller and smaller as I typed:)

Following a past permit that was granted by Portland, a former owner, enclosed the porch of the home. However, there is still a wall seperating the interior living space and the porch. We propose to remove that wall. One of the walls is load bearing. We hired a licensed engineer who provided the requirements for the post and beam sizing. We will insulate the walls, ceiling, and floor of the porch area, install an exterior door at the entrance to the porch, and relocate the baseboard heat from the wall that will be demoed into the exterior walls of the porch. Finally we will install pine boards on the walls and the ceiling.
