Charles D. Radis requests after-the-fact approval for a short section of boardwalk that serves his home at 334 Island Avenue on Peaks Island.

This boardwalk was built several years ago to provide access to his home by his father-in-law, who uses a wheelchair. The Applicant understands the boardwalk lies within the rear and side setbacks for his lot, and a disability variance is being filed simultaneously with this after-the-fact building permit to address that issue.

The boardwalk it applies to the Charles Radis property is shown on a boundary survey prepared by Northeastern Land Surveying dated June, 2015, as amended, a copy of which is enclosed.

The applicant requests an after-the-fact permit for a section of boardwalk that measures 20' x 3'.
