
MAINE REAL ESTATE TAX PAID

## Schedule A

Three certain lots or parcels of land with the buildings thereon, situated on Peaks Island, in the City of Portland, County of Cumberland and State of Maine, being Lots No. 66, 67 and 68 respectively, as shown on Plan of the Eliza B. Littlejohn Estate, made by Jordan & Richardson, Surveyors, September 1895, to which plan reference is hereby made for a more particular description.

Said Lots No. 66, 67 and 68 may be further described as lying next northerly to land now or formerly of the Sterling heirs and next southerly to Herman Avenue, so-called, and next westerly to land now or formerly of Herman C. Littlejohn and are estimated to contain an aggregate of approximately 13,725 square feet.

Also, all right, title and interest in a certain parcel of land situated on said Peaks Island, and being Lot 65 on Plan of Land of Eliza B. Littlejohn, Peaks Island; also being Lot # HH-23 on Portland Assessors Plan 87.
