Dear Marge,

We have been working on the renovation/reconstruction of a property at 14 Centennial Street on Peaks Island, a property adjacent to our primary residence. After much debate, as you know, we have come to the conclusion that the property will be dramatically improved and more in compliance with city regulations if we tear down the original structure and rebuild at a place on the lot more in keeping with setback requirements. 
