Hey Christina, hope all is well. I heard you moved to Bath already, is that right? I hope you are loving it if so.

I have a project at 8 City View Road on Peaks Island that was originally Audie's and then was handed to me. These folks want to remove all of, what they are claiming is invasive, low bush vegetation on a 40 foot bank and replace it with 9-10 feet high riprap and the rest they propose to plan Virginia Rose two feet on center. This is like 1500 plants they are talking about and I don't think anyone has discussed it with SLZ and codes with the City. I put it on Mike Morse's desk to review, but I am also up against a deadline with this one. I thought it was good to go, now that I'm working on it though I am realizing it's not as put together as I thought...

I'm not sure that the applicant's agent is even certified to work in the SLZ. Bob Morin with CRM usually works up in Lewiston and doesn't do many projects down here and I can't find him on our certified contractors list. People have to be certified to excavate within 75 feet of the water in Portland, right? Anyway, just wanted to discuss this project with you and can send a copy of the application if it is not already available at the town office. Thanks!

Hi Jen,

Mike reached out to us about this one. I think the easiest way to proceed would be if you can e-mail me the NRPA application (I haven't seen a copy here - are they supposed to file a copy with the municipality?) and then I can reach out to the owner and contractor to let them know that city permits are also required for this work. And yes, the contractor needs to be certified - I think that's a statewide requirement now.

I noticed in looking at the air photos that it looks like the property to the north, 16 City View Rd, has at least done some clearing and replanting over the last 10 years or so. It's hard to tell from the photos but it looks like they may have done some armoring too (which is probably why 8 City View is inspired to do this work!). Do you have any record of any NRPA Tier or PBR permits for that property? I don't find any city approvals. I'll probably have to go after them, too.
