Parcel One: Land rear N side Frederick St., Pt. Lot 1, Rec. Pl. Rockbound Park, Peaks Island, Maine, Plan 88, Block C, Lot 3, being the same real property as is described in a deed to said Margaret Gockley recorded in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds at Book 10723, Page 223; and
