Dear Mr. and Mrs. Johnson:

At the meeting of the Board of Appeals on Thursday evening, February 23, 1989, the Board voted by a unanimous vote of seven members present to grant an extension for one (1) year of your conditional use appeal to raise domesticated animals (not more than four (4) horses) on your 10 1/2 acres off Vermont Avenue on Peaks Island in the IR-1 Island Residence Zone. The original conditional use appeal was granted by the Board of Appeals on August 11, 1988 and would have expired on February 11, 1989, if you had not requested this extension in a timely manner.
