Dear Ms. Lasky,

An evaluation of the property at 622 Island Ave on 05/17/99 at 12:30 p.m. rev ealed that the structure fails to comply with Section 107.1 of the 1996 BOCA Code of the City of Portland.

107.1 construction of an addition/deck

This is a **STOP WORK ORDER** pursuant to Section 117.1 of the Building Code (1996 BOCA). All construction activity must Stop immediately.

Therefore, you are required to submit amended construction and site plans to this office for review and approval. You must also submit a list of all subcontractors on the job with their addresses and telephone numbers. When you have received approval of the plans and have submitted the requested subcontractor information you may request removal of the "STOP WORK" order.

Failure to comply within *30 days* will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 121.5 of the Code. Please feel free to contact me at 874-8693, if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.
