VIOLATION NOTICE

Dear Donald Anspach,

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on the 18th day of July, 2007 revealed that the premises fails to comply with 30-A.M.R.S.A § 3751, et seq. and § 12-19 of the Garbage and Solid Waste Removal Code of the City of Portland and § 22-3 of the Rodent and Vermin Control Ordinance of the City of Portland.

You are required to provide an adequate number of covered, water tight, rodent proof containers to store all refuse during the intervals between collections for each dwelling unit. You are also required to keep the area clean and free of debris. This shall include removing the discarded construction debris: plastic, rugs, trash, broken glass, and other debris left in the overall yard.

After collection day you are required to pick up any debris that got out of the bags or that was not picked up by trash collectors immediately.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to § 22-9 and 12.79 of the Code. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on 25th day of July, 2007 at which time compliance will be required.

Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in § 6-1 of the Code and in Title 30-A-M.R.S.A. § 4452.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$75.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. If there are any subsequent inspections, however, the \$75.00 fee will be assessed for each inspection.
