Pre-Construction Meeting: The contractor and owner will attend the pre-construction meeting with the City.

Work Product: The contractor is to provide the project in in accordance with the approved plans. All changes to the plan to be approved by the City.

Traffic Control and Work Place Safety: The contractor will corden off the work place area with fencing, barricades, cones and or concrete barriers to control access to the work area. Signs are to be posted noting the closure of the road during construction.
