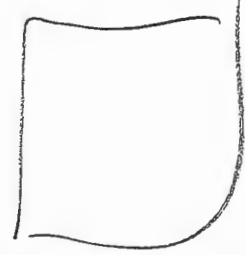





Dear Ted:

This year's event will be held on Sunday September 30th. . with a start time of 7:45 am. Same course as last year (but are seriously considering a course change in 2013 to cross Washington Ave at Bates/Veranda/Tukeys Bridge). We are expecting 3,500+ participants this year. We have placed a cap of 3,500, we expect to reach this cap and not go over. This does not mean we will have 3,500 finishers. We have sold out the past two years.

A Certificate of Insurance has been applied for and you should have it in September. The certificate will mention & cover the banners. Also a certificate for the owners of the building the Congress Street banner is attached to.

Again this year we would like to set up some signage along the Boulevard, two weeks prior. Signage would announce the closure that will take place. In the past, thirteen were placed, and we may add a few for more visibility.

We will have, as usual, hundreds of volunteers working that day, starting at 3am. Parking for race participants is at USM and surrounding streets, the AAA Building and Intermed lots. We have already placed on our web site a notice that there is no parking in the Hannaford Shopping Plaza. This will be announced in others ways to runners, their families and volunteers as race day approaches. This is also announced on our 10,000 entry forms. This has worked out well. Port-a-toilets will be located in the parking lot area of the USM Office. we will have three tents set up near Pedro Field plus a food tent in front of the building that houses Lucid Stage. They, along with the landlords of that building, plus the newly renovated medical building. We do not anticipate any problems here, the landlords have always been very supportive of this event.

Again, we request the following closures:

5am to 2pm – Baxter Boulevard from Preble Street Extension to Bates Street

5am to 3pm – Baxter Boulevard between Forest Avenue and Preble street Extension

5am to 2pm – Payson Park

5am to 2pm – West Kidder Street entrance to Payson Park (the 2pm opening could be on the plus side. The Maine Army National Guard is again doing their tribute march and must be kept closed until they finish.

We propose to leave the Fernald Street entrance to Payson Park open. Location and quantity of city owned barricades, along with number of police officers required for the event can be discussed at our usual September meeting.

ADDITION TO OUR EVENT

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Maine of Southern Maine will be joining us in starting up our **KIDS MAINE MARATHON MILE**. This will take place on Saturday September 29th. Start/finish will be the same as we have now for the adults with a 10am start. It will simply run out Baxter approx. ½ mile and return. In addition to the above closures, we are asking that the start/finish area between Forest Avenue and Preble Street Extension be closed from approx. 9:30 am to 11:30 am and a very brief closure for the ½ mile out and ½ mile back on Baxter of 30 minutes. Many marathons across the country have this addition...a great way to get kids involved in physical activity. Our second year!

As always Ted, we appreciate your help and support. For those whom I have copied and are not aware, I would like to mention that our 2011 event did donate and raise over **\$200,000** for the following:
