- Existing and proposed fire protection of structure.

- Separate plans shall be submitted for:
 - a) Suppression system
 - b) Detection System (separate permit is required)
 - See submitted plans and specifications
- A separate Life Safety Plan must include:
 - a) Fire resistance ratings of all means of egress
 - b) Travel distance from most remote point to exit discharge
 - c) Location of any required fire extinguishers
 - d) Location of emergency lighting
 - e) Location of exit signs
 - f) NFPA 101 code summary
 - See submitted plans and specifications
- Elevators shall be sized to fit an 80" x 24" stretcher.
