Dear SAWYER KIMBERLY D &,

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on 03/05/2018 shows that the structure fails to comply with Chapter 6.Article V. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, The Housing Code. Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. A plan of action for fire door and windows (if needed) are required within 30 days. All other violations shall be corrected within 30 days. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code.

Please feel free to contact me if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$150.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. If there are any subsequent inspections, however, the \$150.00 fee will be assessed for each inspection.

Comments:

Field Inspection 3/5/18- Fire extinguishers need to be removed or be certified for 2018. Unit fire doors are required to self close and self latch. All unit doors required to have numbers labeled. A fire door is required for the basement. CO alarm required in basement. Sprinkler protection required for heating equipment. 3rd floor bedroom windows did not meet egress. Owner will be looking in to seeing if windows meet after removing top of window guards. If windows do not meet minimum standards for egress a plan of action is required within 30 days. All other violations should be addressed within 30 days.
