#### **Conditions:**

- 1) Hardwired photoelectric interconnected battery backup smoke detectors shall be installed in all bedrooms, protecting the bedrooms, and on every level.
  - The same is required for existing buildings, where permanent wiring is feasible; or at the very least battery operated smoke detectors are required. Verification of this will be upon inspection.
