## Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

The applicants are seeking a conditional use permit pursuant to § 14-118(a)(5) of the City of Portland Code of Ordinances to convert an existing two-family residential to a three-family residential with conversion of existing attic space into an affordable housing unit. The Board has authority to consider a conditional use permit application pursuant to § 14-474(a).

The use of an existing space as of September 3, 2008 to accommodate an additional dwelling unit is permitted if it meets all of the requirements of 14-118(a)(5)(a) - (h).
