With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- Please read the conditions of approval that is attached to this permit!! Contact this office if you have any questions.
- Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.
- If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.

The project cannot move to the next phase prior to the required inspection and approval to continue, REGARDLESS OF THE NOTICE OF CIRCUMSTANCES.

#### **Conditions of Approval:**

#### Zoning

1. This property shall remain a three family dwelling. Any change of use shall require a separate permit application for review and approval.

#### **Building**

- 1. Installation shall comply with ASHRAE 62.1 & 90.1 or 62.2, 2007 edition, and the State of Maine gas regulations.
- 2. CO detectors are required in each area within or giving access to bedrooms, and on every level of the dwelling. The detection must be powered by the electrical service in the building and battery.
- 3. The appliance and venting shall be installed in accordance with the UL listing, the manufacturer's specifications and IRC Sec. M1804.2.6.
- 4. Separate permits are required for any electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, heating appliances, including pellet/wood stoves, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.

#### Fire

- 2. Installation shall comply with City Code Chapter 10.
- 3. Fuel-fired boilers shall be protected in accordance with NFPA 101, Life Safety Code.
- 4. NFPA 54, National Fuel Gas Code;
- 5. NFPA 70, National Electrical Code; and the manufacturer's published instructions.
- 6. All outstanding code violations shall be corrected prior to final inspection.
