Kitchen Work - summer/fall 2013 - Hartwell Residence

A. Walls & Doors:

- 1. Remove existing plaster & lathe on exterior walls in old portion of kitchen area (not including existing sun room area)
- 2. Insulate stud bays with closed cell foam insulation (approx. R-15)
- 3. Cover walls with new taped ½" drywall
- 4. Remove existing interior walls marked "X" on floor plan (non-loadbearing)
- 5. Add non-loadbearing walls and door shown as dotted lines on plan in order to create closet space by door to side hallway
- 6. Replace exterior door and weathered sill in existing sun room area with new ThermaTru 2'8" x 6'8" Full View single bore door with frame or equivalent

B. Ceiling:

- 1. Remove existing plaster & lathe on ceiling in old portion of kitchen area (not including sun room area)
- 2. Insulate ceiling joist bays with fiberglass batts (approx. R-13)
- 3. Replace ceiling with boxed coffers constructed of 3/8" drywall + 11/32" plywood secured to joists, connected by 1x3 clear solid pine to form faux beams. Ref. Katz, G. M., *Fine Homebuilding* http://www.finehomebuilding.com/how-to/articles/perfecting-coffered-ceilings.aspx

Notes:

- existing appliances and cabinetry to be kept
- existing appliances and cabinetry (except for sink cabinetry) to be temporarily removed to facilitate renovation work described above and reinstalled after completion
- new hardwood floor to be installed (building permit not required subfloor to remain intact)
