Submission Guidelines for Decks

It is intended to help you supply proper and complete drawings and documents. Please label all of the following items on your plans. Refer to the <u>One- and Two-Family Addition/Alteration Checklist</u> for complete submission requirements and instructions.

- ✓ A plot plan showing all existing and proposed structures with distances to property lines and dimensions of the proposed deck platform(s) and stairs
