RENTAL HOUSING REGISTRATION FOR	V

Revised 11-11-2016

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Chapter 6, Article VI of the City of Portland Code of Ordinances requires owners and managers to register rental units with the City of Portland Housing Safety Office. A rental unit is any portion of any residential structure that is rented or available to fent for any length of time to an individual(s) who is not the owner(s). Registration is due beginning January 1, 2016 and within thirty (30) days of renting a property. The ANNUAL registration fee of \$35 per individually rented bed, room, and/or dwelling unit less any discounts (listed on the second page) is due at the time of registration and on January 1 of each year. Fallure to register may result in a fine.

Complete the Rental Housing Registration Form and Owner's Pre-Inspection Checklist for EACH RENTAL PROPERTY (multiple rental units at the same property with the same owner can share the same form) and return to the City of Portland Housing Safety Office by email, fax, mail, or in person. After the registration information and fee discount documentation has been verified, an invoice for payment will be sent to the party certifying registration entered below. Complete applications may pay at the time of registration.
