An evaluation of your property at 34 Glenwood Ave on Aug-23-2000 revealed that the structure and premises fails to comply with previous violation notices sent on Feb. 18,2000, May 27,2000 and June 28,2000.

Attached are copies of the notices.

The property continues to be in violation of Chapter 6, Article V, Sec 6-118 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland Housing Code.

This is a notice of intent to prosecute. The matter is being referred to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code, and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452. There will be a re-inspection of the above property on Oct-05-2000. **Please be advised that because this is a letter of intent to prosecute and there are repeat violations, Section 6.2 of the Code requires that you pay a \$75.00 re-inspection fee.** This must be paid prior to Oct-05-2000. Failure to pay the assessed fee within 30 days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Code.
