HAND DELIVER

An evaluation of your property at 285 Woodford St. on November 2, 1999 revealed that the premises fails to comply with 30 A.M.R.S.A and Sections 12, 22-1, 22-3, & 22-20 of the Garbage and Solid Waste Removal Code of the City of Portland.

The following is a list of items in the overall yard: discarded miscellaneous cardboard boxes, empty oil containers, mattresses, wood & boards, plastic buckets, ironing boards, broken chairs, metal pipes and various miscellaneous rubble.

These violations are the same as documented on previous violation notices dated September 9, 1999 and October 14, 1999. You have 14 days to comply with this notice. I will re-inspect your property on November 18, 1999.

This is a notice of intent to prosecute. The matter is being referred to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code, and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A.
