property is scheduled for July 1984.

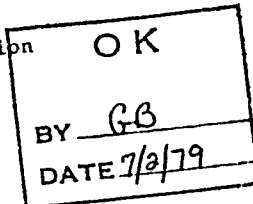


