

Use History of Property

10/6/70 Permit 70-1195 was approved to build one story office building – zone B-1.

12/23/81 Permit approved to change the use from office building to “non-profit private club” for the Jewish Community Center which included a 1250 sf addition. Condition 3 of the approval letter stated “off street parking for 25 cars will be provided on site”. The zone was still B-1.

9/26/95 Permit 95-1018 approved the use as a “nonprofit Community Center with daycare facility”. The Conditional Use as a daycare was granted by the ZBA on 9-21-95. Zone changed from B-1 to R-5 around 1989.

The use of 57 Ashmont Street as a private club for the Jewish Community Center was approved in 1981. In 1995 it was called a nonprofit community center still operating as the Jewish Community Center. A change of use was not necessary for the Sahara Club to occupy the space as a private club in August of 2017 because the use at the current use at the time was a non-profit private club/nonprofit community center.
