Steve,

Thanks for this. It supplies a lot of good background information.

To sign off on this, however, we are going to need more specific and quantitative information relative to the original condition of approval (which you should review), including parking counts at regular intervals over the course of a typical weekday and weekend (see reference to this in my email below). We will also need numbers with respect to the Woodford's Club. These numbers should be compared against originals to show how the actual, lived parking situation compares to the projected/planned.

Likewise, the condition specifically calls out "the efficacy of the parking management plan (including proposed transportation demand management measures)." We need some direct reflection on the parking management plan, again, in terms of how it is playing out in lived experience. I'm attaching the original parking analysis and final parking management plan here for reference.

Let me know if you have questions. Otherwise, I'm hoping that you can provide this info in relatively short order.
