Please be advised that because this is the second inspection and there are repeat violations, Section 6.2 of the Code requires that you pay a \$75.00 reinspection fee. This must be paid prior to July 15, 1999. A Certificate of Compliance will not be issued until all reinspection fees are paid. Failure to pay the assessed fee within 30 days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Code.
