Dear Mr. Ridlon:

An evaluation of your property at 6-8 Clinton Street on January 26, 2001 revealed that the conditions of the property fail to comply with Section 12-78 of the Junked Motor Vehicle Ordinance of the City of Portland.

The following old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicles were found stored on the above property:

- Black Ford Probe
- Dodge Black Pickup Truck
- 3 Junked Pickup trucks snow covered
- White Box style Commercial Truck
- Chrysler 2-toned wood black and wood grain convertible sedan Lic. Plate #96ER w/expired inspection sticker and expired registration sticker

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 12-79 of the Code. All of the above vehicles shall be removed within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection will occur on March 15, 2001 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply with this notice will result in this matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 and 12-81 of the code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss4452
