An evaluation of your property at 109 Glenwood Ave on Oct-04-1999 revealed that the structure fails to comply with Section 119 of the Housing Code of the City of Portland.

The violations are as follows: Garage is structurally unsound/rooted roof/floor

Dilapidated garage severely rotted and falling down. 119.1 all unsafe structures shall be taken down and removed or made safe, as the code official deems necessary and as provided for in this section. Please obtain a demolition from the City of Portland.

Based on that list, and pursuant to section 6-120.(1)(2)(3), this office declares the dwelling unit is unfit for human habitation. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on November 5, 1999 at which time the dwelling unit/structure must be totally removed and/or secured from vandalism. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A.M.R.S.A. ss4452.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code. Please feel free to contact me at 874-8705 if you wish to discuss this matter or have any questions.
