




To follow up our phone conversation of last week, enclosed is a copy of Lease Agreement which the Hales have signed for their Falmouth property.

As we discussed on the phone, the Hales will be moving into 208 Concord Street sometime in June and I trust this lease of their home in Falmouth provides sufficient assurance that the Hales will, in fact, be establishing residence at 208 Concord Street in June, 1990. I have advised Mr. Hale that he will need to obtain an occupancy permit prior to moving in.
