





- 3. REFER TO ELECTRICAL & STRUCTURAL DRAWINGS & SPECIFICATIONS FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
- 4. THIS DRAWING SHOWS GENERAL ITEMS OF SELECTED DEMOLITION AND IS NOT INTENDED TO SHOW ALL CUTTING AND PATCHING ITEMS REQUIRED TO ACCOMMODATE NEW WORK. IT WILL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REMOVE & DISPOSE OF ITEMS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT.
- 5. ALL REMOVED MATERIALS ARE TO BE DISPOSED OF PROPERLY.
- 6. MAINTAIN STRUCTURAL ¢ WEATHER TIGHT INTEGRITY THROUGHOUT DEMOLITION.


