STOP WORK ORDER

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on 11/01/2017 revealed that building construction was being conducted without benefit of a valid building permit as required by Section 105.1 of the 2009 International Building Code and the 2009 International Residential Code of the City of Portland.

Appropriate permitting has not been issued for the property listed above, therefore all construction activity at that property must STOP immediately. This is a STOP WORK ORDER pursuant to Section 114. of 2009 International Building Code and the 2009 International Residential Code of the City of Portland. You may resume construction activity only after issuance of the appropriate building permit and the subsequent lifting of this order. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A of M.R.S.A. Section 4452. This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 112 of the City of Portland Building Code.

Violation: BUILDING W/O PERMIT; Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair

move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to

the building official and obtain the required permit.

Notes: Stop Work Order issued for the work being done on the front of the building. Owner must apply for an

building permit.

Comments: New porch being built without permit. Pillars cut, new railings being put in, new floor boards, new stairs.

Looks like new support beams put in under porch as well. A building permit application is required.
