Dear Jennie, We communicated with you recently about this project, and today we are submitting for permits. This cover letter describes our request for a Site/Civil/Foundation/Structure Permit + Demo Permit to be followed by Building Permit.

Level III Site Plan and Subdivision Approval

On March 28, 2017 the project received Level III Site Plan and Subdivision approval. The approved site plan includes a 21' wide easement area, jointly used by 502 Stevens Ave (this property) and 510 Stevens Ave (abutting property), permanently dedicated for Access, Utility and Drainage. One condition of approval requires that:

ii. The applicant shall provide finalized easements for shared site access for review and approval by Planning Authority, Department of Public Works and Associate Corporation Counsel.

Reason for Initial Site/Structure Permit

Because obtaining approval of the easement from all parties (multiple property owners, attorneys, City Attorney etc) takes time, and because we are scheduled to begin construction in June, we request to break out a Site/Civil/Foundation/Structure Permit to get started soon - while the easement is being reviewed and approved by all parties. We will follow-up and submit for a building permit - and by then the easement will be finalized - before the building permit is issued.
