- 1. A code review for IBC and NFPA (even a building shell is required to analyze code compliance per the most restrictive assumed use)

- 3. Comcheck for at minimal the thermal envelope
- 4. Architectural plans with at minimal elevations and sections including all building elements, exterior window & door schedule
- 5. If you will be looking to install the in slab drainage and domestic supply with this phase please include the drainage fixture unit calculations and commercial fixture requirements per the UPC 2015?
