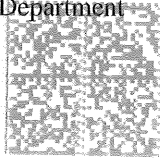


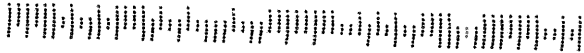

**IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM CITY OF PORTLAND
PLANNING DIVISION**

IN THE VICINITY OF 605 STEVENS AVENUE

To Residents and Property Owners: An Application was received and the Portland Planning Board will hold a workshop to consider a plan by Motherhouse Associates, LP and Sea Coast at Baxter Woods Associates, LLC for proposed rehabilitation of the former St. Joseph's Convent (known as the Motherhouse) into 88 units of senior housing, with 66 affordable units and 22 market rate units, along with 73 parking spaces/9 handicap spaces for this proposal. The application includes the subdivision of the 18.98 Sisters of Mercy site at 605 Stevens Avenue into four lots, with Lot 3 (4.39 acres) for the Motherhouse senior housing proposal. The workshop is an opportunity for the applicant to present a plan to the Planning Board in an informal session which is open to the public. Public comments will be taken at this meeting.
