## Submission Guidelines for Decks

The following is a guideline of information required for the review of a building permit application for a residential deck. It is intended to help you supply proper and complete drawings and documents. Please label all of the following items on your plans. Refer to the One- and Two-Family Addition/Alteration Checklist for complete submission requirements and instructions.

- ✓ A plot plan showing all existing and proposed structures with distances to property lines and dimensions of the proposed deck platform(s) and stairs
- ✓ Additional drawings showing all of the following information:
  - 1. Type of foundation system
  - a. Diameter of concrete filled tube or pre-cast concrete pier size
  - b. Depth below grade (minimum 4' below grade)
  - \_/c. Spacing of tubes
  - 2. Posts (members supporting framing of floor system)
    - ✓a. Wood size, type and location
    - b. Anchorage of post to footing
  - 3. Framing members
- AJA a. Ledger size attached to building
  - b. Lag bolt size and spacing on ledger
- N/★ c. Lateral attachment to building
- d. Location and type of flashing
  - e. Girder size and spans carrying floor system
  - f. Joist size, span, spacing and hanger type
  - 🖊 g. Decking size
  - ✓ h. Post connection
  - 4. Guardrails and handrail details
  - a. Guardrail height
    - b. Baluster spacing
    - c. Handrail height
  - 5. Stair details
    - a. Tread depth (measured nosing to nosing)
    - b. Riser height
    - c. Nosing projection of tread

    - e. Landing size(s)

Note: The pathway to the leck will be stoped such that wheel chairs can directly assess the deck.
