Dear Ms. Keyes;

An evaluation of the property at 165 Ocean Avenue 11/15/99 revealed that the structure fails to comply with Section 107.1 of the 1996 BOCA Code of the City of Portland. Building construction is occurring without valid permits.

This is a **STOP WORK ORDER** pursuant to Section 117.1 of the Building Code(1996 BOCA). All construction activity must Stop immediately.

Therefore, you are required to submit an application to the code official for the following activities, and these activities shall not commence without a permit being issued in accordance with Section 107.0.

Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452. This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 121.5 of the Code. Please feel free to contact me at 874-8706, if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.
