2. The Wall Type W1 is listed as 1 hour rated. As there are no tags for W1 on the walls and infill, is the assumption that all the walls will be constructed as such, and is this a required rating? The wall description (s) should contain the head of wall detail, ie. to the underside of the roof deck, or other, and if a fire resistive joint is required.

Per the discussion had about the project, <u>all</u> new wood walls are to be one hour rated, in lieu of a non-rated, non-combustible system. There is no rating required, but in order to resolve the issue of the wall types, we are providing a 1-hour rated system. (also now stated on the drawings)
