The Portland Planning Authority has reviewed and approved a revision to the approved site plan for Waste Management of Maine at [REDACTED] with the following condition:

1. That the construction and demolition material area shall be kept in a clean condition with no debris outside the dumpsters and that existing screening and buffers shall be retained and not disturbed.

The approved revision includes designating a 50' x 100' area on the site plan as a construction and demolition material consolidation area within the existing container storage area. The approved submission includes a revised site plan dated 6-16-98, a DEP application and a Construction and Demolition Material Consolidation Operations Manual.
