Dear Ms. Stacey,

When possible, I would like to set up a meeting with you, myself, and my general contractor, Randy Johnson, to discuss zoning issues that have emerged in the process of obtaining approval for a construction permit for 23 Saint Joseph Street in Portland. My first contact at the Portland Code office, Laurie Leder, suggested I contact you for this purpose.

At issue, as I understand it, is that in the process of demolishing the existing garage (Demo Permit ID 2016-02810) and replacing it with a new structure that respects the footprint and volume code requirements, the resulting structure will have 7' cross ties instead of the desired 8' cross ties. The additional 1 foot height could be allowed if the existing structure was 5' from the property line but it is, in fact, only 4'7". Because the new structure will house my workshop, the 7' cross ties could potentially create a hardship getting materials into and out of the building.

Please let me know when we might meet to discuss any available options.
