- 2) 108.2 Conformance. Temporary structures and uses shall conform to the structural strength, fire safety, means of egress, accessibility, light, ventilation and sanitary requirements of this code as necessary to ensure public health, safety and general welfare.
- 3) This permit DOES NOT authorize any construction activities. The tent/stage must be removed at the end of the event.
- 4) Approval is subject to compliance with City and State Food Codes per the Portland Public Health Dept.

- 4) Tents shall have an approved fire resistant rating and maintain 10' between stake lines. No smoking or open flame allowed within 10'. Provide at least one 2A:10 BC fire extinguisher.
