KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT: That Marisa J. Roskelley of 26 Adelaide Street, Portland, ME 04101, for consideration paid grant(s) to Durp LLC, a Maine Limited Liability Company, of 112 Woods Road, Falmouth ME 04105, with WARRANTY COVENANTS:


A certain lot or parcel of land, with buildings thereon, situated on the Northwesterly corner of Adelaide (formerly Harmon) and Bell Streets, in the City of Portland, County of Cumberland and State of Maine and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron hub set in the ground at an angle caused by the intersection of the Northerly sideline of said Adelaide Street with the Westerly sideline of said Bell Street; thence running Northerly along the line of said Bell Street ninety-nine and forty-one hundredths (99.41) feet to an iron hub set on the line of said Bell Street; thence Westerly seventy-one and five one hundredths (71.05) feet, following the back line of lots Nos. 11 and 9 on a plan of the Bell property, so-called, recorded in the Registry of Deeds for said County of Cumberland, in Plan Book 9, Page 71; thence Southerly through the center of said Lot No. 9, one hundred one (101) feet, more or less, to said Adelaide Street; thence Easterly following the line of said Adelaide Street, seventy-eight and ninety-one one Hundredths (78.91) feet to the point of beginning. Meaning and intending to convey Lot No. 11 and the easterly half of Lot No. 9 on said Plan.


