It has come to our attention that you are selling crafts from your home on a regular basis. Your property is located within an R-3 residential zone with prohibits retail uses. The Board of Appeals is specifically prohibited from granting a retail use within any residential zone, so you would not have the right to appeal.

It shall be necessary to cease this activity immediately. All goods shall be removed from the yard and all signs/banners shall be removed in kind. If the retail sale continue to exist within 10 days after the date of this letter, it will be necessary to turn this matter over to our Corporation Counsel for legal action.

If you need help looking for a new location within a proper business zone, I will glad to meet with you and show you our zoning map and explain what zones would be available to you for retail sales. If you have any other questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at 874-8695.
