It has come to our attention that you are selling crafts from your home on a regular basis. Your property is located within an R-3 residential zone with prohibits retail uses. The Board of Appeals is specifically prohibited from granting a retail use within any residential zone, so you would not have the right to appeal.

It shall be necessary to cease this activity immediately. All goods shall be removed from the yard and all signs/banners shall be removed in kind. If the retail salse continue to exist within 10 days after the date of this letter, it will be necessary to turn this matter over to our Corporation Counsel for legal action.
