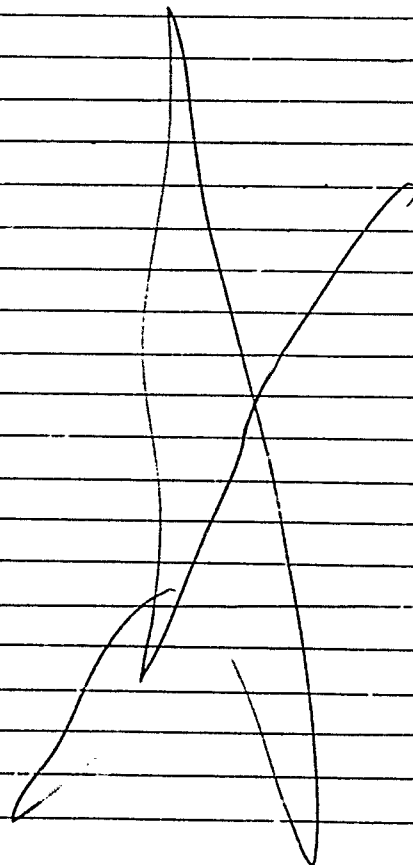

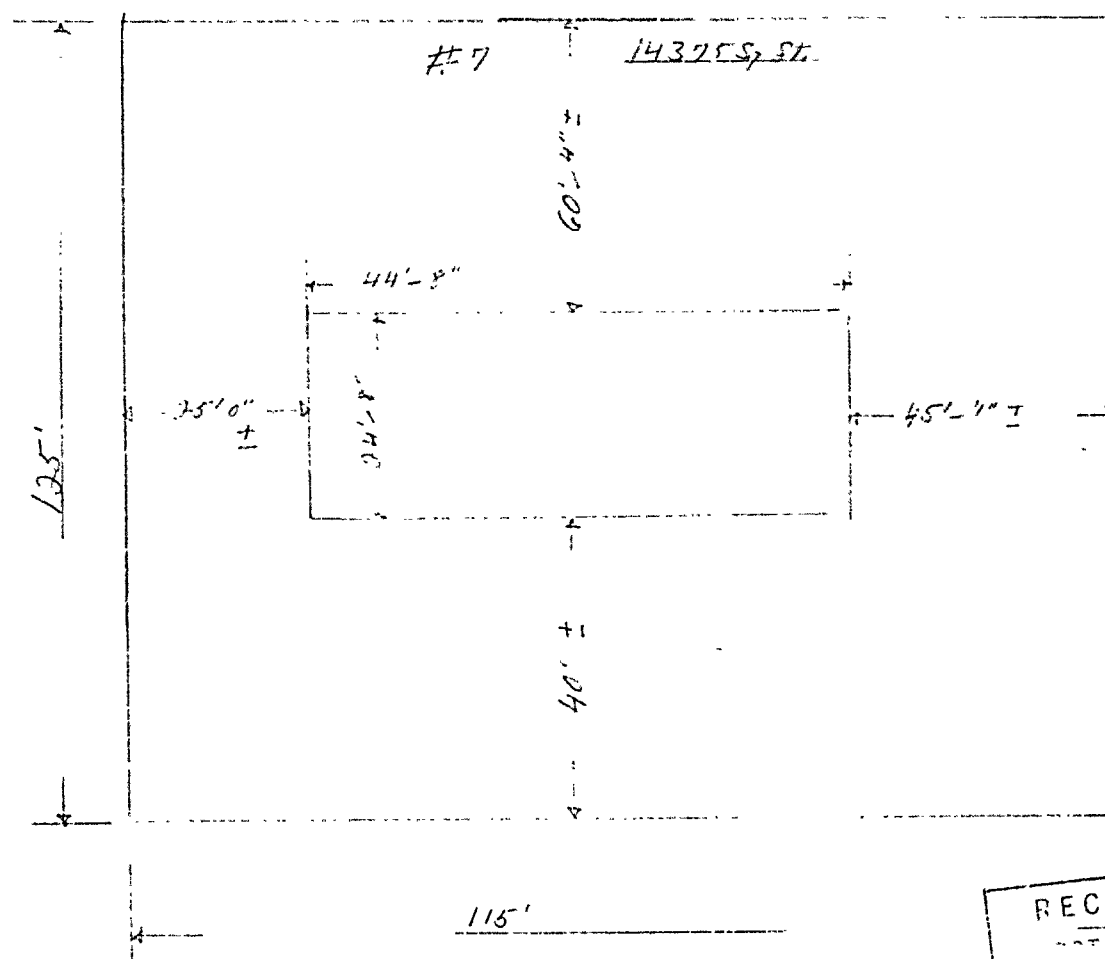

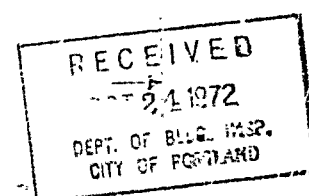

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Salvaggio:

This office represents Mr. and Mrs. John Alcorn who own the land next to you on Harvard Street in Portland. Since Mr. Alcorn is in the process of planning to build a home on his property (designated as Lot #3 on a Plan of Campus Realty Co.), he asked surveyors from H.I. & E.C. Jordan to go out to the property and prepare a final survey. The surveyor discovered that your home, located on Lot #2 on aforesaid Plan, is located in part on the Alcorn property. I am enclosing, for your interest, a copy of the Plan prepared by H.I. & E.C. Jordan and you will note that the house itself encroaches on the Alcorn property for a distance of 1.03 feet, with additional encroachment of the chimney of 1.57 feet. I note that the zoning regulations of the City of Portland require a minimum side yard setback, which is also being violated by the present location of your house.

On behalf of my clients, I hereby give you notice to remove the encroachment upon the Alcorn property and to comply with the applicable City of Portland zoning ordinance relating to side yard setbacks.

I urge you to contact an attorney regarding this matter so that your rights might be fully protected. A copy of this letter is being sent to the Department of Building Inspection of the City of Portland so that they might proceed with their own investigation.

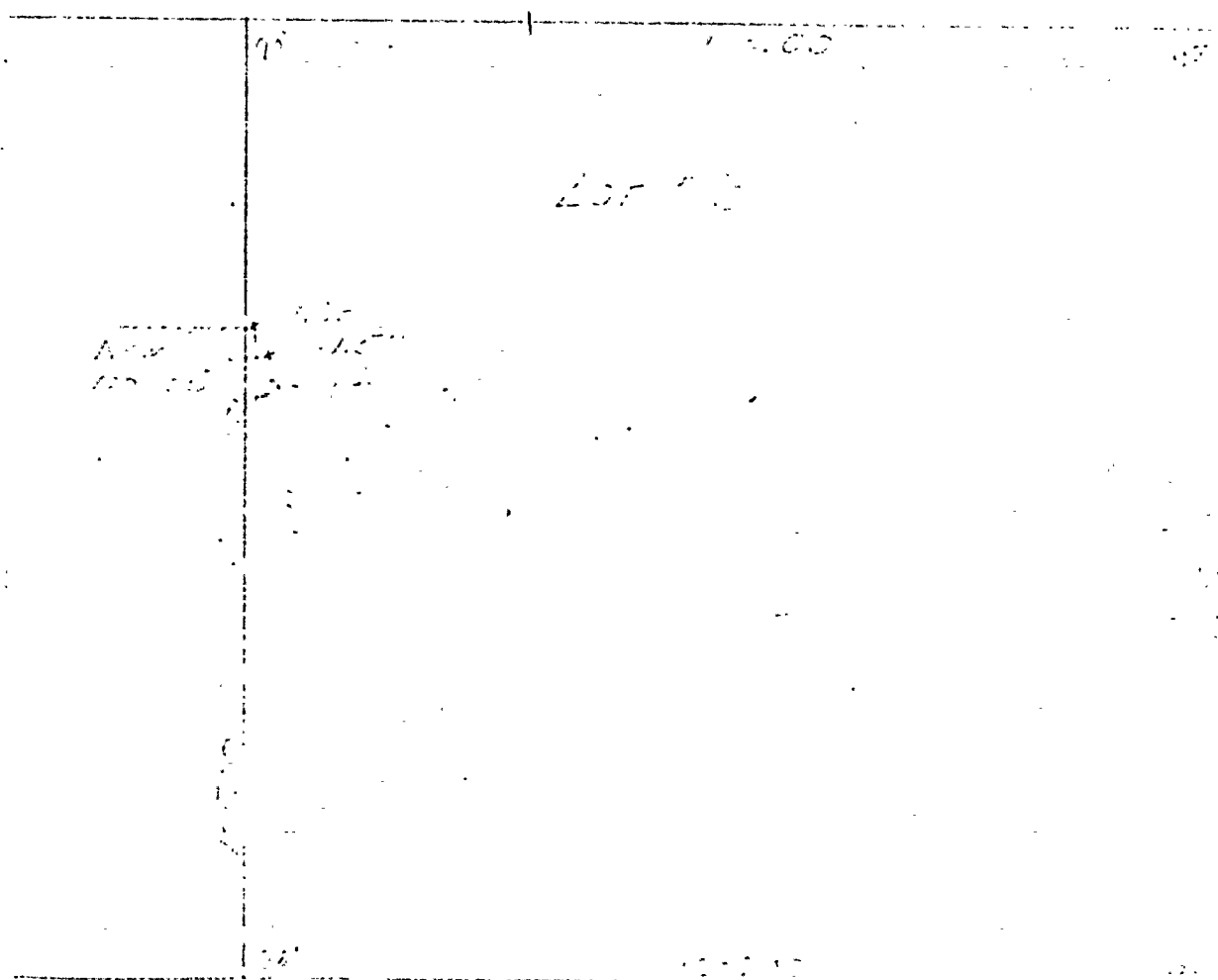

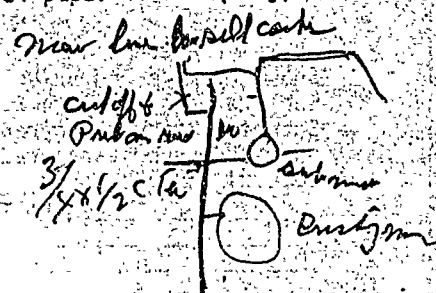

If the application is approved 3 copies will be made, one will be mailed to the Portland Water District, one will be forwarded to the City Plumbing Inspector and one will be mailed back to the Applicant. If the application is denied, one copy will be made and mailed to the applicant showing reason for denial.

Fourth - Upon receipt of a copy of the approved application, the applicant can purchase and install the sub-meter at approved. Following installation the applicant or his plumber must call the Chief Plumbing Inspector at 775-5451 Ext. 234 for an inspection of the completed installation. Following inspection by the Chief Plumbing Inspector, the Water District will be requested to seal the sub-meter and arrange to have an automatic reading system (if applicable - see General Information Right) installed where by the volume shown by the sub-meter will be credited on the Sewer User Charges of the Bill.

Submetering of Water Volume. Any person who feels that recorded water meters are not a reliable index of his discharge volume may install an additional water meter of a type approved by the Director to measure the volume of water which can be shown not to enter the sewerage system. The person installing such a meter shall immediately notify the Director of such installation and shall be responsible to the Director for recording meter readings not less often than every three months. Such person shall be credited with the volume charges for the volume shown by such meter, which meter shall be accessible for reading by the City or its agents at all reasonable times.

The City and the District have arranged to relieve the customer from the reporting responsibility required above if both meters can be read simultaneously by the District meter readers during their regularly scheduled visits to read the pre-existing service meter. This can be accomplished by locating the sub-meter directly adjacent to the pre-existing service meter or by enclosing the sub-meter located elsewhere with a remote reading register located so both readings can be made at the same time.

Approved meters are: Neptune and Rockwell meters, conforming to the following specifications:

1. shall meet or exceed JIS accuracy test requirements and be accompanied by a certificate of test accuracy.
2. the meters will have straight reading, cubic foot registers.
3. the meters will have the meter number stamped into the main case.
4. the meters shall be magnetic drive.
5. shall have either a rotating disc or oscillating piston.
6. shall have a bronze case.

Approved meters are available from the Water District, which sells them for the price the District buys them from the manufacturers. If you wish to purchase a sub-meter from the District you must bring your copy of an approved application with you at time of purchase.
